

Some animals hibernate in the winter.



Some leave for warmer weather while others stay and grow very thick fur to keep warm. Did you know some animals hibernate in the cold winter to survive? Hibernate means their breathing and heart rate decreases; they sleep a lot more and they don't eat. Their body temperature drops and they get fuel from all the food they ate in the Fall. Many types of mammals, reptiles, amphibians and even insects hibernate. Some species of these animals are hibernating right now—bears, hedgehogs, bats, frogs, turtles, mice, bumblebees, and more. *When the weather warms up, they will be hungry!*


